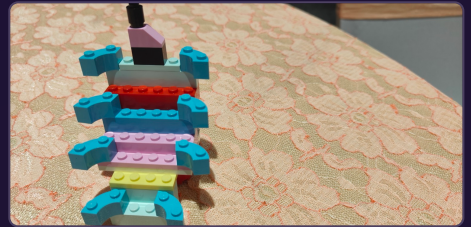
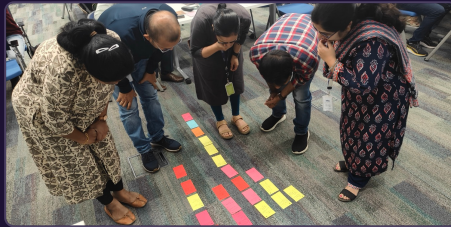

DAY 1

THINK BETTER WITH AI
